The Superintendent, Building Administrator, and/or designee may order the closing of any and all schools whose operation on a short-term basis would pose a serious threat to students or staff. Such emergencies may be caused by weather conditions, equipment breakdown, bomb threats, or health problems. The Superintendent will also have the authority to delay school opening or dismiss early due to inclement weather or other emergencies. In all cases, staff and the public will be notified according to a predetermined plan. The Board chair will be notified as soon as practicable when school is closed for emergencies.
